Get your child to tell you the Must Haves for Procedural Texts:

Procedural Writing - How to
Purpose of procedural texts are 'to inform'!
They are 'how tos'
How to: build something, make a recipe, put something together etc. Must haves:

Title that clearly tells the reader what they are going to be doing A clever introduction that captures the reader's attention List of ingredients or materials (usually in a frame) May have labelled pictures/Diagrams

Steps that are numbered
Steps that include present tense verbs (put, take, stir place)
Usually have adverbs to help the reader (place carefully, stir briskly)

May have: callouts, tips, facts, different coloured font, different sized font etc.
